## **2024 Online Writing Instruction Community Symposium**

We know how Bill Hart-Davidson was also a cheerleader for so many others in the Writing Studies field. So, in honor of the late Bill Hart-Davidson, <u>The Online Writing Instruction Community</u> will be hosting another **free** fully online symposium.

The theme of the symposium will be an inspiring phrase often spoken by Bill: "Give. When in doubt, give more."

Giving in academia can happen in many ways. While it is more obvious when we give in a face-to-face scenario, we all know that giving in an online space happens too. With this symposium, we want to explore the theme of giving in in two ways:

- 1. What is something you could give to the audience of the symposium? A tip, trick, strategy, etc. that you use in your online courses?

- Giving in the way that you handle your administrative duties
- Giving in the many other ways that giving happens
- Giving by presenting about a strategy you use in your online courses that could help others
- Giving by presenting about a strategy you use with your online writing faculty
- Giving by sharing knowledge, like participating in this upcoming symposium and sharing your knowledge with attendees!

We invite scholars of all ranks/positions to submit a proposal to present at the upcoming symposium. We will consider all proposals submitted, but we will be limited on the number of proposals we can accept due to time constraints.

Presenters will be able to choose between a 5-minute ignite talk or a traditional presentation of 10-minutes or less. Whether or not you knew Bill Hart-Davidson, we encourage you to think about the ways you can give presence and knowledge through your participation in this symposium.
