

IWCA 2025 Summer Institute June 16-20, 2025 Universidad de las Américas Puebla, Puebla, México

All writing center professionals welcome!

This Summer Institute is appropriate for both early and later career writing center professionals who are interested in inclusive dialogue on literacy across cultural and linguistic contexts. The bilingual program (English and Spanish) will include lectures, workshops, debates, book presentations, and cultural activities. All components are designed to offer an overview of the diverse perspectives from which we approach academic reading and writing, while acknowledging the sociocultural, institutional, and pedagogical specificities of each context.

Registration: Deadline: June 5

Registration Fees (based on country of residence):

- Participants from North America (United States and Canada), Europe, and the Middle East: \$730 USD (includes tour).
- Participants from Asia and Oceania: \$500 USD (includes tour).
- Participants from Latin America, the Caribbean, and Africa: \$300 USD (includes tour).
- Participants from Mexico: \$230 USD (without tour) or \$300 USD (includes tour).
- Online attendees for keynotes: \$100 USD.

Registration includes daily lunch and snacks during the four days of on-campus activities and a cultural excursion (transportation) to Cholula, Tonantzintla, and the city of Puebla on June 20. Registration does not include Airfare, lodging, breakfasts, dinners, or transportation within Mexico. Travel grants are available to assist with costs.

Lodging: Discounted rooms available at the UDLAP Hostel and at the Hilton Garden Inn

Travel: Recommended: Fly direct to Puebla International Airport (\$10 USD taxi/Uber to UDLAP campus/lodging). Alternative: fly to Mexico City and take an <u>Estrella Roja bus</u> to Puebla—approx. 3 hours for \$22 USD.
